
Treasurer Test

The Treasurer Test is a specialized online assessment designed by treasuryXL in collaboration with treasury experts to evaluate the essential skills and knowledge required for treasury professionals. It assesses your strengths and areas where additional training might be considered across four key treasury disciplines:

- Risk Management
- Corporate Finance
- Cash Management
- Treasury Miscellaneous

It measures knowledge, speed, productivity, and accuracy, giving you insights into which areas you excel and where further development could be beneficial.

Reading instructions: Treasurer Test

The questions in the test were presented in order of increasing complexity, and correct answers to the more complex questions are rated with a higher score. It is not expected that you answered all questions within the allotted time. There are four different peer-group categories, based on years of experience in treasury:

- 1. 0 years treasury experience
- 2. 1-2 years treasury experience
- 3. 3-8 years treasury experience
- 4. 9+ years treasury experience


Your absolute score shows your level of treasury knowledge relative to others in the market within your (1-2 years of treasury experience) peer group.

Upper semi-circle

The percentage of the questions you answered correctly is compared to the percentage that your peer group answered correctly. If you score on the right-hand side, your "percentage right" is relatively high.

Lower semi-circle

Your absolute score is compared to the score of your peer group and is achieved by answering many questions correctly, with extra weight given to correct answers for complex questions.



The relative strengths underlying your score

This overview shows how strong you are on the various subjects. Should your absolute score be slightly higher, then the average of your relative strengths will also be so. If the differences between your relative strengths are significant, these differences can also be interpreted as an opportunity for further development.
